I milk directly into mason jars and pour directly into filter/jar and seal. All utensils & jars are washed on sanitize cycle of dishwasher.

Please describe your milking practices (pre- and post-milking process included):

Using clean jars and sanitizing our hands, using baby wipes and/or brushes to make sure goat is clean, dipping teet in a betadine/water solution before and after milking, straining milk after each teet.

Milk Handling:

Time lapse from milk collection to bottling and straining: < 5 mins

Time lapse from straining to chilling: < 15 mins

Method of chilling milk: Putting Directly in freezer or small Fridge set @ 34° If using freezer taking out @ 45

Bottle and container cleaning procedures: Sanitize setting on Dishwasher mins. Placing strainers & covers in a clean sealed bag for transport & tote for milk so that it never sees the sun

Cleaning Agent: Dishwasher w/detergent Bleach Solution *Ratio to water: _____
 Other: Apple Cider Vinegar in the Rinse cycle.

*Note: Milk is labeled with collection date and stored between 33-40° F until pick-up. 35-45° F.

I give my goats Vitamin C Chewables & Calcium Chewables (w/o Aspartame or other harmful things) as a preventative measure. My Goats are brushed and hooves cleaned/trimmed weekly. Feed quality food twice daily as well as Hay & at will, watered twice daily adding a tablespoon of baking Soda to prevent bloat. My Vet does routine exams and can testify to the quality care I give them all.
